

- Each team consists of at least 3 players per team. The 3 highest players combined rating should be under 7200 in U-7200 Team, under 3900 in U-3900 Team
- Team Event will be based on first come first serve basis. Maximum entries are 24 teams
- Seeding in the draws is based on the Oct. Canadian ratings available at the time of the draw.
- The Tournament Committee may estimate the rating of any unrated player at any time during the tournament and remove that player from any event for which such a rating would make the player ineligible.

Format;

- Team events Each team will have 3 players A, B and C (Host), or X, Y and Z(Guest). There will be five singles matches in team competition: A vs Y, B vs X, C vs Z, A vs X, B vs Y; All matches are best 3 of 5 to 11 points. The team who won the first three matches is winner.
- All events shall have preliminary round robin of 3 best of 5 games to 11 points followed by single knockout.
- Tie-breaks in round-robins will be decided by score of matches, games, points, only of those players involved in the tie.
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel any event due to insufficient entries.

- Current ITTF Laws of Table Tennis will be in effect.
- All rackets must be one side black and one side red with ITTF approved coverings.
